- Applicants must have a Minimum 3.5 Cumulative G.P.A. as of the end of Winter Quarter 2018 .
- All completed application materials **must be received by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 13th 2018.**

Please note: *Applicants are encouraged to apply for as many of the AS Scholarships they choose; but each student is limited to receiving one AS Scholarship per academic year.*
